

AGREEMENT – POLICIES, RULES & REGULATIONS, WAIVER, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, & AGREEMENT TO HOLD HARMLESS

All students are required to review, agree to, and abide by the Indy's Grooming School's policies, rules and regulations, in effect, and subject to change from time to time. By signing below, the student acknowledges receipt of a copy of the current policies, rules and regulations of Indy's Grooming School, a copy which is attached to this Enrollment Agreement & Application. Indy's Grooming School, at its sole discretion, may amend its policies, rules and regulations, at any time, and the student agrees to abide by any such amended changes from the date of adoption. The student understands that specific grooming experiences is dependent on dog availability, and that Indy's Grooming School can not be held responsible for unavailability of specific breeds and trims. Students are subject to termination if they do not strictly adhere to all of Indy's Grooming School's policies, rules and regulations as outlined in the grooming school's catalog.

The student understands that dog grooming is a physical activity, and that participating in the Indy's Grooming School program is not without risks, including that some of the dogs to which the student will be exposed to may be difficult to control, and may be the cause of injury when handled with the greatest amount of care. the undersigned hereby waives and releases Indy Ray, Anside Animal Hospital, and its employees and agents from any liability of any nature, for injury or damage, including specifically, but without limitations, any injury or damage resulting in participation in Indy's Grooming School, the undersigned hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Indy Ray, Anside Animal Hospital, and its employees and agents from any and all claims for injury or damage sustained while attending Indy's Grooming School, or any function of Indy's Grooming school, or while on the grounds or surrounding area thereto as a result of any actions by any dog.

The terms and conditions of Indy's Grooming School programs shall be enforced in accordance wit the laws of the State of North Carolina, and all agreements are deemed to have been made in the State of North Carolina. In the event of litigation regarding the terms and conditions of Indy's Grooming School program, the parties expressly submit to the jurisdiction of the federal and state's courts located in North Carolina.

Admission Procedures & Policies

Application Requirements

Students must be 18 years of age or older. Prospective students are required to:

1. Complete and sign all application forms
2. Submit application with application fee and deposit in amount currently required by Indy's Grooming School.
3. Have an interview with a representative of Indy' Grooming School.

Prior Experience and education can not be applied to programs and courses.

Notification of Acceptance

Once these three requirements have been met, Indy's Grooming School will assess the student's application and make a determination regarding acceptance for admission. Applicants will be notified of the status of their acceptance by phone call or email. Indy's Grooming School reserves the right to reject any applicant for any reason.

Re-admission

Students who withdraw from the program for any reason may submit an updated application for re-admission along with a new application fee and required information. Students applying for re-admission must have a record of their previous transcript, which will be evaluated to determine which course component have been successfully completed. Tuition fees will be assessed on an individual basis in the event of re-admission.

Tuition and fees

The application fee of \$250 will be applied to your tuition and is charged to offset Indy's Grooming School costs involved in the processing the applicant. This fee is refunded if the applicant fails to gain school acceptance, but is non-refundable if the applicant does not attend or drops out before the end of the course (see refund schedule below). All tuition fees are due in full seven days prior to the start of the course, unless prior arrangements have been made and accepted in writing by the school.

Tuition includes all required grooming equipment, supplies, manuals and books, instruction, and a certificate of graduation. Tuition does not include meals, lodging, transportation expenses related to student's dog/cat, or any other items not mentioned above.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

It is our sincere hope that students will not withdraw once they have been accepted into the program, but in the event of unforeseen circumstances, our policy includes the following schedule of refunds:

- Up to fourteen days before course starts, full refund minus \$250 Application fee.
- Withdraw less than three days before course starts, 75% refund of tuition. (\$6k) Forfeit all Application fees.

When you are accepted for enrollment, the school purchases all your materials and equipment needed for grooming at that time. All materials are the property of Indy Grooming school until the program is completed and certification issued. In other words, you are not entitled to education materials or equipment until the course has been completed. This explains the reduction of refunds of tuition. First, to cover the costs of enrollment and second, to deter deceptive intentions of prospective students. No exceptions.

Refunds will come in the form of a Check from Ansede Animal Hospital.

PROCEDURES FOR STUDENT GRIEVANCES.

A. If a student should have a complaint or grievance, send an email of the specifics to doctor@docansede.com. We will make a reasonable effort to investigate the matter and work with the student for a suitable outcome or compromise.

B. If a reasonable solution can not be reached, the student may withdraw from the course, but there will be no refunds. If the student wishes to re-enroll later, fees may be waived or reduced.

This agreement releases Ansele Animal Hospital and Indy Ray from all liability relating to injuries or illnesses that may occur while participating in Indy's Grooming School activities. By signing this agreement, I agree to hold Ansele Animal Hospital and Indy Ray entirely free from any liability, including financial responsibilities for injuries incurred, regardless of whether injuries are caused by negligence.

I also acknowledge the risks involved in grooming. Such injuries include, but are not limited to, animal bites, slipping, falling, and equipment malfunction. I swear that I am participating voluntarily, and that all risks have been made clear to me. Additionally, I do not have any conditions that will increase my likelihood of experiencing injuries while engaging in this activity.

I understand that Ansele Animal Hospital and Indy Ray will vaccinate for or have verifiable proof of rabies vaccination on all grooming patients.

I am 18 years of age or older. I have read all documents. I am signing it freely and understand the legal consequences of signing this document. By signing below, I forfeit all right to bring a lawsuit against Ansele Animal Hospital and Indy Ray. I will also make every effort to obey all safety precautions as explained to me.

I understand that this document is written as broad and inclusive as legally permitted by the state of North Carolina.
